

Ponce Inlet Political Signs

Quick Reference Guide

1. Signs are limited to four (4) square feet in size, and no higher than four (4) feet in height (*residential districts*); in non-residential districts, the election sign shall not exceed sixteen (16) square feet in area, and if sign is displayed as a free-standing sign shall not exceed six (6) feet in height;
2. One sign per parcel, *per candidate* is allowed. If the property is located on a corner lot (two frontages), one sign per candidate is allowed on each frontage;
3. Signs must be a minimum of five (5') feet from the edge of roadway (paved or unpaved). If the width of the buffer strip is less than 5 feet and there is a sidewalk, the sign may be placed at a safe distance from the sidewalk, farthest from the roadway;
4. Signs must be removed within seven (7) calendar days after the election date;
5. No permit or fee is required for political signs;
6. Placement of signs is prohibited on town-owned properties and/or facilities;
7. These regulations are in addition to and compatible with those established by Florida Statute 106.143.
