Comments:

- On Tuesday, October 14th at approximately 8:30am, Ponce Inlet Police Officers along with members of the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Taskforce conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle as it exited a residence on Riverglen Blvd. The driver was identified and immediately taken into custody. He was charged with outstanding warrants for the sexual assault of a minor.
- On Wednesday, October 22nd the Ponce Inlet Police Department began live streaming 911 emergency calls directly to police officers on patrol. This software solution called "Live911," developed by HigherGround, Inc., allows police officers in the field to hear every detail of the incoming emergency call while also providing the 911 caller's exact location on a map. Implementing Live911 should reduce response times even further during emergencies by giving officers on patrol a "head start" to the incident location.
