Comments:

- On November 13th, 2025 at 8am, officers responded to Off the Hook Restaurant and Marina for a vandalism call. Overnight, an unknown suspect damaged the parking lot, rope chains, and wooden bollards. The total damage amounted to \$1,500. Officers reviewed video footage and identified the vehicle as a dark colored Chevy HHR. They queried the License Plate Readers and found a similar vehicle exiting the town a few minutes after the crime. Investigative efforts led them to Atlantic High School where they located the vehicle with damage consistent with the crime scene. A 17 year old suspect was pulled from class and arrested on scene. He was processed at the Ponce Inlet Police Dept. and transported to the Volusia County Family Resource Center.
- Volusia County Communications upgraded their CAD reporting system mid-month. This month's report shows the total from both systems and their overall combined total in the monthly report.
