Comments:

- On January 20, 2026 at approximately 7:00 am, Ponce Inlet Police spotted a suspicious Black Kia Soul traveling on S. Atlantic Avenue through Ponce Inlet. They attempted to stop the vehicle but it fled northbound at a high rate of speed toward Daytona Beach Shores. Officers disengaged from the chase. A lookout was given to surrounding agencies. Shortly thereafter, a Port Orange Officer driving an unmarked car spotted the Kia Soul on Dunlawton Ave. The vehicle fled from Port Orange police who ultimately canceled their chase. A short time later the vehicle wrecked into a truck at the I-95 intersection. Two black male juveniles wearing masks fled from the vehicle. They were quickly captured. The vehicle was stolen out of Sanford, Florida the previous night and inside the vehicle was a stolen gun. Both juveniles were charged accordingly.
- On January 23, 2026 at approximately 6:00am, Officers responded to suspicious persons in the 4500 block of S. Atlantic Ave. Two suspects were arrested after they entered a residence without permission. They were charged with burglary, criminal trespass, and Loitering and Prowling.
- On January 24, 2026 at approximately 3am, Ponce Inlet Officers observed a male enter a condominium in the 4700 block of S. Atlantic Ave. The male was acting suspiciously in the lobby. Officers ordered the man to walk outside but he refused. He was eventually detained and officers learned that he had no reason to be at the location. He was arrested and charged accordingly.
